## **MEDIA ALERT:**

"A Hundred Million Reasons" Suicide Prevention and Resilience Workshops

July 9, 2023 ~ Manoa Public Library, Honolulu, Hawai'i ~ Free

WHY: In Hawaii, one person dies by suicide every two days (Dept. of Health). It's the second

leading cause of death among young adults ages 15-24 and adults ages 25-34 (HIPP 2023). **Suicide is preventable**. The goal of "A Hundred Million Reasons" is to raise

awareness about suicide prevention and build mental resilience and strengths.

**WHAT:** For High School Students:

"A Hundred Million Reasons: Sources of Strength" is a free workshop that will help high school students, who may invite a trusted adult, to develop mental wellness and resilience. Presented by Deborah Goebert, Dr.P.H., Professor University of Hawai'i, John A. Burns School of Medicine, Dept. of Psychiatry and the Office of Public Health

Studies; and co-chair of the Prevent Suicide Hawaii Task Force.

For Parents, Community Leaders, and Faith Leaders:

"A Hundred Million Reasons: Keep Me Where The Light Is" is a free workshop that will help parents, community leaders, and faith leaders to learn a strengths-based approach for suicide prevention, hope, and resilience, grounded in Hawaiian values. Presented by Pua Kaninau-Santos, MSW, ASIST trainer, SAFETALK provisional trainer, Aloha, Mo'olelo & Suicide Prevention Basics Facilitator; and Su Atta, LSW.
